Sadler key features

1. Arm-to-footrest link

When not using your stairlift, you can fold away the arms and the footrest will fold automatically. There's no awkward bending down, which is particularly useful at the top of the stairs.

2. Saddle seat

The unique saddle style seat enables you to maintain a more upright posture and minimises the weight supported by your legs. The assisted lift feature offers easy entry and exit from the chair.

3. Seatbelt

The easy-to-use seatbelt fastens and unfastens with one hand and it's easy on arthritic hands. The stairlift will not operate unless the seatbelt is securely fastened.

4. Easy-to-use controls

Ride the Sadler using our simple, intuitive controls that have been designed for those with less dexterity. They work with the lightest of touches, and can be operated using your hand, arm or wrist.



5. Safety edges

If something obstructs the stairlift, sensors on the edge of the carriage and footrest will automatically bring the stairlift to a stop.

6. Wall controls



Our clever wall controls are ideal for when you need to summon your stairlift from another floor, or perhaps send it up or down to someone else who needs to use your Sadler.

From the simple controls at your fingertips to reliable operation and a flexible and compact design, we have done all the hard work so you don't have to. Just settle into the comfortable seat and sit back, as you travel up or down your stairs with ease.

We really have taken care of every detail to ensure your Sadler stairlift is as effortless to use as it is easy to operate.

Step 1: Simply unfold the arms of your Sadler and the footrest will safely unfold into position.

Step 2: Once unfolded, sit on your stairlift and make yourself comfortable in the seat. Then pull across and fasten

the easy reach seatbelt and you're now ready to go.

Step 3: Gently apply pressure to the easy-to-use light touch controls in the direction you wish to travel and your Sadler will glide smoothly up or down the stairs.

Step 4: When you arrive at the top of the stairs, the rail will continue onto your

landing so that you can alight safely and securely from your Sadler.

Step 5: When you are not using your Sadler, the arms and footrest fold neatly away, allowing more space for other stair users to pass safely.
